

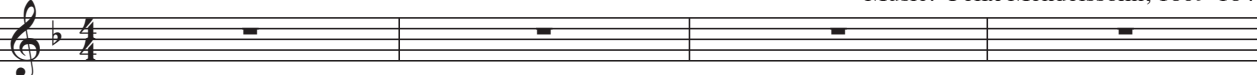

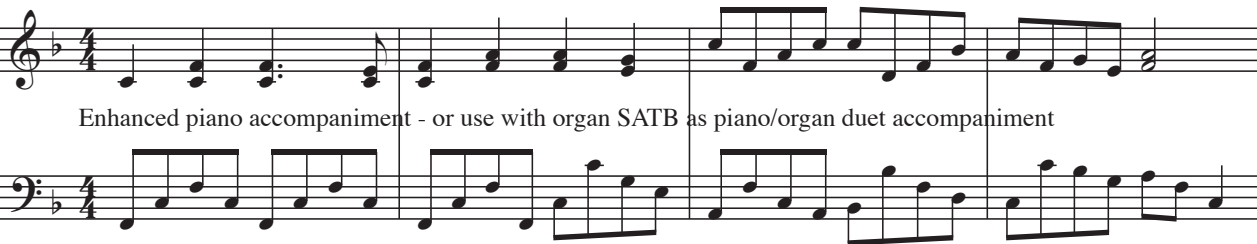

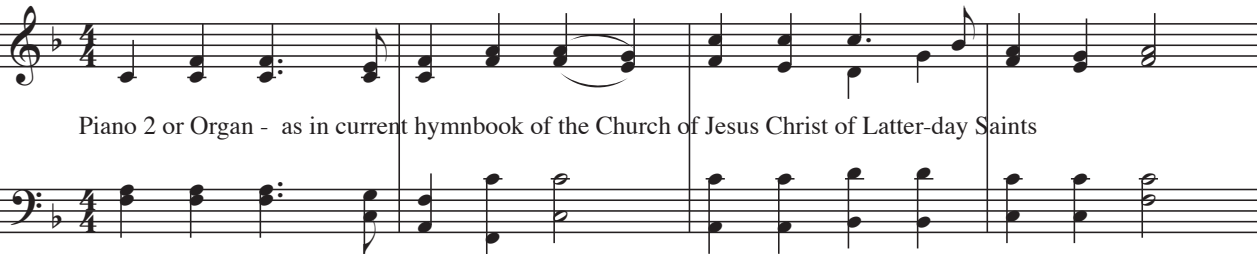
Optional instrumental countermelody - for flute, violin, oboe, organ, etc. - suggested for verse 2
