This hymn, being just one verse, is normally quite short. A lovely way to extend the hymn would be as follows:

Verse 1: congregation sings the hymn as usual, with organ SATB accompaniment

Verse 2: choir or soloist sings the countermelody, with enhanced piano or SATB organ accompaniment.

Verse 3: the two melodies are put together, congregation singing the main hymn melody while the choir or soloist sings the countermelody.
