**Some Ideas for Using Congregation Choir for Primary Music:**

1. Add a vocal or instrumental countermelody to a special presentation
2. In Singing Time, have the Music Leader or another adult sing the countermelody while the children sing the melody.
3. In Singing Time, have a child play the countermelody on the piano (perhaps up an octave) or on another instrument while the children sing.
